2. MARKET AREA

The market area covers central Pargas and Köpmansgatan. Signs directing visitors to the market area will be put up the day before the market.

The market area is divided into four product-category sections

- Fashion, interior décor & toys
- Local talents (businesses & associations)
- Craft quarter
- Environment

3. SIZE AND PRICE OF SALES SPACES

REMEMBER THAT ONLY PAYMENTS MADE BEFORE THE DUE DATE GUARANTEE THE RESERVATION OF THE SALES SPACE!

4. SET-UP OF SALES SPACE

Each seller is responsible for setting up their own sales space. The organiser has the right to inspect the sales spaces and determine any necessary changes. Set-up should be completed before the market begins. The seller will receive the number of their market space one week before the event. The information desk will be open for any questions.

We require every seller to provide sufficient weights to

secure the anchoring of the sales stand / tent under all conditions. Every seller is personally responsible for any damage that may occur due to inadequate anchoring.

5. ELECTRICITY

The organiser installs the power distribution units, but the seller must provide any necessary extension cords themselves (at least 20 m / sales space). NOTE! The use of ungrounded or indoor-use (white) extension cords is not allowed.

Report your electricity needs when booking your space.

Electricity charges are as follows:

1-phase (regular power) 16A 20 €

3-phase (power current) 16A 40 €

6. TIME

Official sales hours are Saturday at 10–16

7. INFORMATION

8. SALES PERMITS

Game booths and similar operations must comply with the regulations that apply to that activity in order to obtain a permit, and each person responsible for such a booth must obtain a permit from the police authority themselves.

9. SALE OF FOOD

When booking a space, the seller must report all food products that the seller intends to sell during the market. The organiser will send the information to the Food Authority.

The sale of food products whose "best before" date has passed is prohibited! Such products may only be sold in exceptional cases with a special permit issued by the event organiser based on a statement from the health authorities.

10. PROHIBITED PRODUCTS

The sale of all drug-related products is strictly prohibited.

11. FIRE SAFETY

Open flames without a permit are prohibited. All companies handling open flames or gas equipment must have adequate firefighting equipment. This means at minimum a 6 kg powder fire extinguisher that has been inspected within the past year and has a fire rating of at least 34 A 233 BC, or a 6 litre liquid extinguisher with a fire rating of at least 43 A, or a 6 litre foam extinguisher with a fire rating of at least 34 A 183 B. A 4x4 m sales space may have a maximum of 25 kg of gas. Spare cylinders may not be stored at the sales space. A maximum of 25 kg of LPG may be stored in the vehicle.

12. DRIVING CARS INTO THE MARKET AREA

Driving cars within the market area is permitted on Saturday before set-up until 9:30 and for dismantling after 16:00

When the market is open, it is not permitted to drive a car or have a car parked within the market area without the organiser's permission.

13. CLEANING

The seller is responsible for cleaning their sales space before leaving. Cardboard and plastic sorting facilities are available.

14. NAME SIGN

All sellers participating in the market must have a sign at their sales space stating the seller's name and home town. The appearance and material of the sign are optional. The size must be at least A4. If a name sign is missing, we charge €5 for producing a sign.

15. GENERAL REGULATIONS

By paying the space fee the seller undertakes to comply with the above terms of participation as well as any other instructions and regulations given by the organiser or its representative.

The transfer of the sales space in whole or in part to someone else without the organiser's permission is prohibited.

16. EQUIPMENT RENTAL

The organiser arranges / rents out sales tables if needed. Equipment must be booked when booking the space.

17. MARKETING

The market is marketed in, among other places, the following media: Local newspapers, social media and road signs.

18. CANCELLATION OF SALES SPACE

The space may be cancelled free of charge until 30 April 2026.

No refund will be given for later cancellations. The right of withdrawal does not apply to events agreed for a specific date and time.
